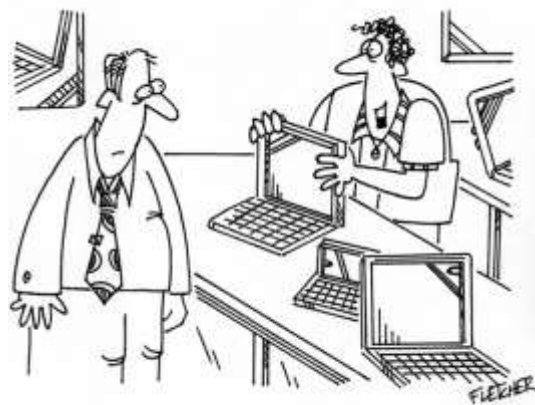
THIS SUNDAY AT GRACEWAY
