v.2 How was David tempted? Who is at fault?

- Temptation comes . . . James 1:13-17
- What is our defense against temptation?

- 1 Corinthians 10:13
- “Flee” 1Corinthians 6:18, 10:14; 2Timothy 2:22; 2Peter 1:4.
- Genesis 4:7 Need to master allurements to sin.

V.3 David did not flee nor look away. What did he do?

- 2 Samuel 23:34, 37 Who are Eliam and Uriah?

V.4-5

- The results of sin are often evident

V.6-13

- How does David try to hide his sin?
- What is the man’s response?

V.14-25

- David gives orders
- David accepts a troubling military report

V.26-27

- What is David’s eventual action? Is this right?
- Is God pleased?
